
English language courses for B1 or B2 students

Overview

These courses have a double objective: understanding the Anglo-Saxon world, and developing linguistic skills (written and oral comprehension, written and oral expression). The objective is to be able to understand and present a theme, to express a personal point of view and to defend it with a constructed argument. The materials used are varied and linked to current events.
